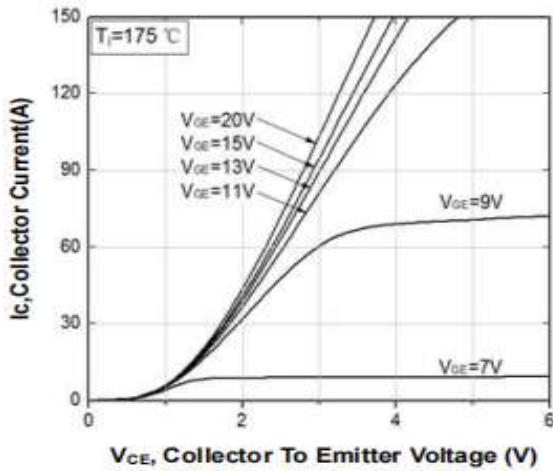

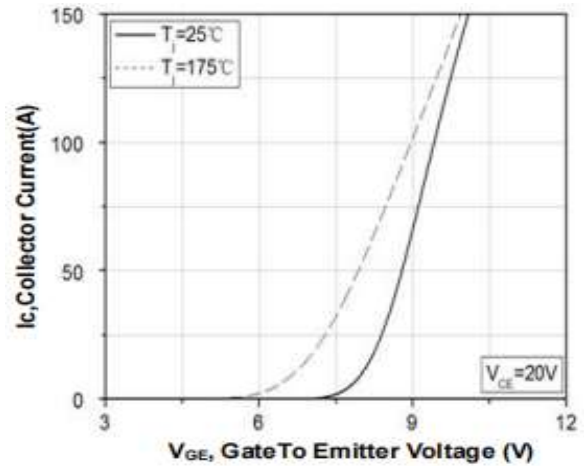




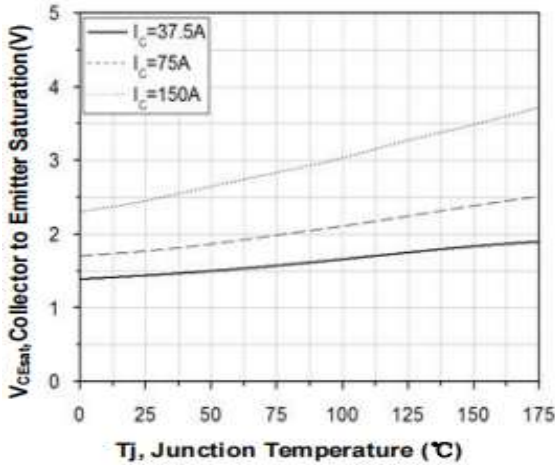

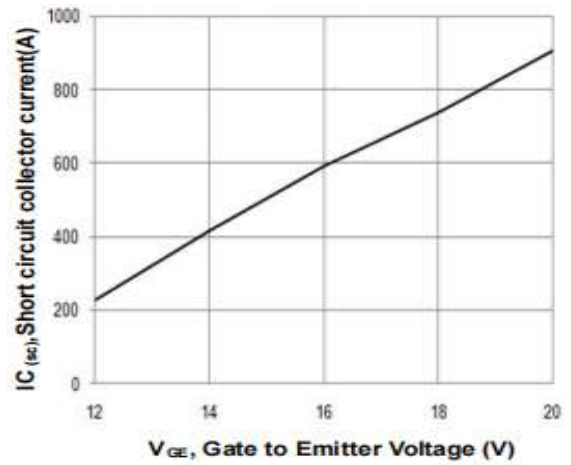
Output Characteristics



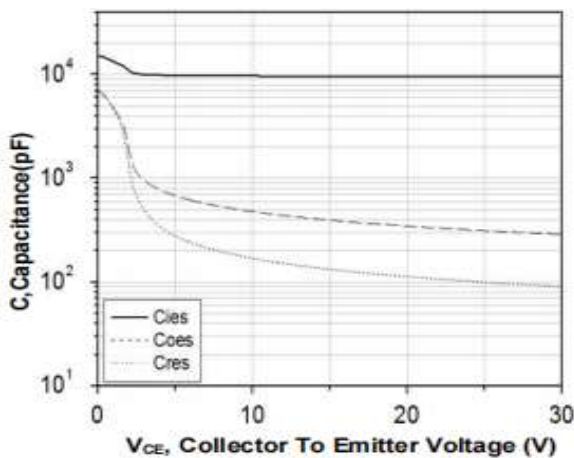

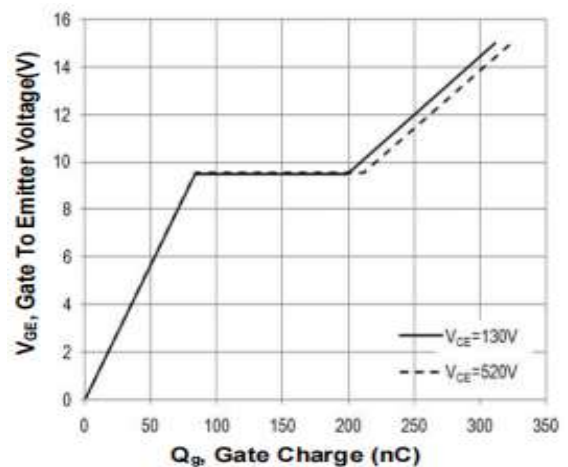
Typical collector-emitter saturation voltage as a function of junction temperature ($V_{ge} = 15\text{V}$)

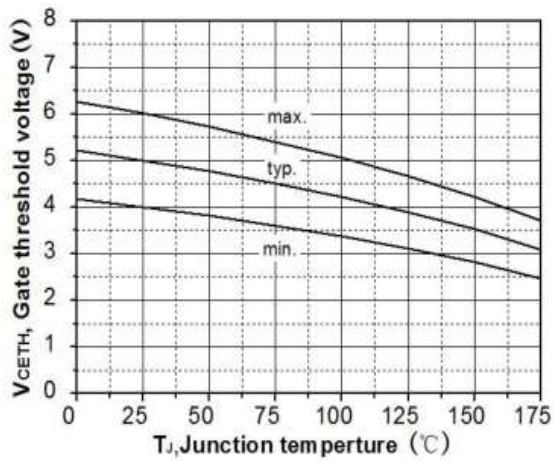

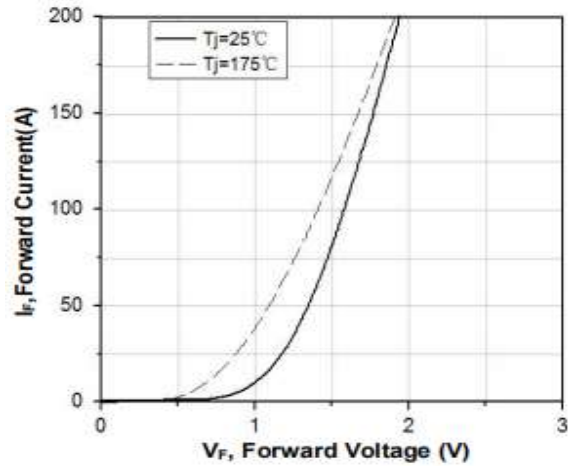


Typical gate charge
